## **Regulation of Electronic Devices employment by students in the Classroom**

To enhance the learning of the student's technology may be employed in the classroom. The guideline is to outline the possible use and the regulation of using technology in classrooms.

- The course instructor should decide of permitting the type of technology in his/her class room. Any illegal use of technology is forbidden. The course instructor should decide whether the manner the electronic devices is used disrupt the classroom or not and can report the incidence accordingly.
- 2. Laptop, Tablet, Smart Phones etc. can be permitted in classroom at the discretion of the course instructor. These devices can be used to take notes, opening the eBooks, reading charts and tables, using simulation software and other applications as instructed by the course instructor. Some specific purposes use of technology such as messaging, playing games and Internet surfing are strictly prohibited. Specially for smart phones, the device must be muted at all times and must not be answered during class. Any misuse such as recording of the classroom is strictly prohibited. Failure to adhere to the usage of electronic devices in classroom regulation may render the student subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the university rules and regulations.
- 3. Technology usage in the classroom should be outlined by the course instructor at orientation session at the beginning of the semester and the guideline should be available on the course syllabus.
- 4. To avoid any possible cheating in the examination, only the exams code of conduct is applied and these guidelines are overruled.
